Adolescent Health, "Risk Behaviours"
Psychosocial Screening in Adolescents
Update 16/5/03

The development of the ASQ (Adolescent Screening Questionnaire) is now complete. This is a 3-page questionnaire that includes questions about the participant's connection to family, friends and school; tobacco, alcohol and drug use, physical activity, eating patterns and mood as well as sexual activity. The questionnaire takes less than 10 minutes to fill in. The Adolescent Screening Questionnaire is currently being validated. Michele has been approaching all new admissions to 3 East, the Adolescent Ward, to take part in the study. So far, 58 participants have been recruited. Participants are asked to complete the questionnaire and undergo an interview. At the end of data collection the answers on the questionnaire will be compared to the interview notes.

Michele has been enjoying the interaction with the young people. A number of parents have mentioned that they felt that the study was useful and felt that doctors should be finding out more about young people's behaviours.

Embarrassed?!

Are you embarrassed to ask your friends and colleagues for a donation?
